Camp Boddie

Enjoy the picturesque coastal waterfront vistas leading you into and out of Camp Boddie, part of the East Carolina Scout Reservations which boasts 880 acres of beautiful eastern North Carolina wilderness. Local scout staff and volunteers are excited to host our riders at this rest stop and share more about the Boy Scout Camp opportunities provided at Camp Boddie.

- Southside Produce

Take a break from the bike to enjoy fresh strawberries and other produce available for purchase from this outstanding local produce farm. There will also be fresh strawberry lemonade available and homemade strawberry ice cream.

Grimesland Town Park

This rest stop is always a favorite thanks to the small hometown, homespun hospitality and the festive atmosphere. Enjoy live music from the Six Pack from 10:30am to 2:30pm while you enjoy a \$5 basic lunch of hot dogs and chips that the local fire department will be onsite selling. There will also be neat, local t-shirts for sale as well as local volunteers that will be happy to tell you more about the area.

Rest Stops include:

- Goose Creek State Park

Enjoy breakfast courtesy of the Ignite Church volunteers that will be onsite helping us with this rest stop. Once you've filled your belly, be sure to explore the interesting Visitor Center to learn more about Goose Creek State Park and all it has to offer.

- Bonner Point in Historic Bath

First settled in the 1690s and then incorporated in 1705, Bath is North Carolina's first town. Staff from this historic site will be dressed in historic era clothing and eager to share with you more about the rich history and legends of the area including that of Edward Teach, also known as Blackbeard the Pirate. There are also great lunch options close by including Blackbeard's Tavern, Old Town Country Kitchen and Quarterdeck Marina.

- Belhaven Town Dock

Belhaven is the birthplace of the Intracoastal Waterway which means this waterfront rest stop is sure to provide you with amazing views. There are also a number of neat shops and eateries close by such as ICW Brewery and Cloud9 Creamery that we encourage you to check out before heading back out on your route.

Acre Station Meat Farm

Founded by Ernest and Nancy Huettmann back in 1977, Acre Station Meat Farm is a unique place to eat and explore featuring everything from delicious cheddar-cheese biscuits to fresh from the farm meat, unique candies, preserves and more. The Huettman family's commitment to "Fresh Cuts, Friendly Service" is as true today as it was in 1977 so be sure to take some time to explore and get to know more about the Huettman family.

Rest Stops include:

- Griffin Family Farm

Founded in 1996, Griffin Farms Inc. is a family-owned farming operation and the producer of corn, soybeans, wheat, sweet corn and other value-added crops. Family members will be onsite to share their story.

- Deadwood Western Theme Park

Take some time to explore this family-owned-and-operated (and family built) Western Theme Park featuring a mini golf course, roller coaster and more. Members of the family will be onsite to talk about this special place and you will definitely want to ask them about the unique metal work all around the park.

- Woolard Family Farm

In addition to a fully operational farm, the Woolard family also runs Billy Ray's Truck and Equipment which serves the entire East Coast. We could go into more detail but the family will be around at the rest stop and we'd rather let them tell the story of this unique operation. Kings Chicken Food Van will also be onsite with homemade breakfast biscuits available for purchase.
