Perched at more than 5,000 feet, this scenic stop offers sweeping views of the surrounding Blue Ridge Mountains and a perfect opportunity to catch your breath, refuel, and snap a few photos before continuing on the Blue Ridge Parkway. In addition to 20 acres of open field for cultivation and pasture, River View Farm also features 13 acres of wildlife rich forest ground with a wide variety of old growth tree species. The Farm’s goal is to develop a fully organic regenerative farm that incorporates the production of vegetables, fruits, and livestock in a mutualistic environment. Trailside Brewing Located along the Ecusta Trail, Trailside Brewing is a local hub where craft beer, great food, and community come together. With spacious indoor and outdoor seating, a friendly team, and a packed calendar of events, this local favorite is the perfect place to relax, refuel, and enjoy Brevard’s welcoming atmosphere before finishing the 2026 Mountain Ride!
