Day 1: Sunday, October 4 (Mount Airy to Eden)

- Guilford Courthouse Military Park

Learn about this pivotal American Revolution battle between Commanders Nathanael Green and Lord Cornwallis interpreted by the National Park Service historians and rangers.

- Greensboro History Museum

Discover the city's history in the textile industry, its famous people, and more at this Smithsonian Affiliate Museum.

Day 2: Monday, October 5 (Eden to Hillsborough)

- Thomas Day State Historic Site

Hear fascinating stories of this freedman considered to be the father of NC's furniture industry.

- Milton with the Mayor

Enjoy a personal history lesson from the Mayor about the town's history in the tobacco and flour market.

- Yanceyville Museum of Art

Experience the unique rural works of regional artists.

Day 3: Tuesday, October 6 (Hillsborough to Henderson)

- Historic Oxford Bus Tour

Take in the grand residential architecture and vibrant commercial district.

- Afternoon Delight - A Tasting of Oxford

Oxford small businesses invite you to enjoy samples of local beverages and treats!

Day 4: Wednesday, October 7 (Henderson to Weldon)

- Littleton Museum Experience

Morning museum stops range from the "not so normal" like the Cryptozoology & Paranormal Museum, featuring the mysteries of Bigfoot and haunted artifacts, to the more conventional stops at Person's Ordinary and the Roanoke Valley Veteran's Museum.

- The Roanoke Canal Museum

Round out the day by learning about this 19th century commerce superhighway.

Day 5: Thursday, October 8 (Weldon to Edenton)

- Sylvan Heights Bird Park

Home to the breeding populations of some of the world's rarest waterfowl. In some cases, fewer than 250 individuals of these species remain in the wild!

Day 6: Friday, October 9 (Edenton to Manteo)

- Bearolina

The largest population of Black Bears in the world make their home in Washington County. Learn all about them at God's Creation Wildlife Museum & Bear-Ology. Add visits to the Roanoke River Maritime Museum & Lighthouse and the Port O'Plymouth Museum for a complete day in the riverfront town of Plymouth.

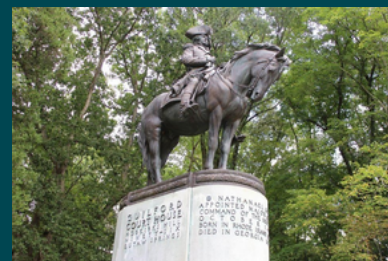
Day 7: Saturday, October 10 (Manteo to Hatteras Island)
